



The Advantage of Having CEU Credits Assigned to Your Session

The NKBA recognizes providers of quality continuing education through its Continuing Education Unit (CEU) Program. NKBA-certified members look to CEU-approved presenters to update or broaden their professional knowledge and skills. In 2021, Voices From The Industry presenters have the opportunity to award .1 or .15 NKBA CEUs for attending their presentation. Presenters will attract NKBA certified members who are looking to increase their knowledge and gain CEU credit to maintain their certifications.

Note: Approval applies to KBIS 2021 only. It cannot be transferred to another venue or presentation date.

- If you are selected as a speaker for KBIS 2021, your session will automatically qualify for NKBA CEUs for NKBA-certified attendees, depending on the session's length.
- You must provide at least two (2) Learning Objectives/Goals that will be a clear statement of what the attendee should learn. These must be clearly defined.
- You must provide at least three (3) topics and time allotted for each topic.
- Your session must total 60 or 90 minutes, including time for questions and answers.

Additionally, if you are selected as a VFTI presenter, and hold an NKBA certification, you will earn .3 CEU credits per session.
